I am honored to invite your children to join the China Immersion Programme (CIP) at the end of this year. The following are the details:

◇ **Date:** 1st Dec 2005 – 14th Dec 2005

◇ **Place:** Beijing

◇ **Aims:**

- ① to provide China immersion chance to enhance understanding of Chinese culture and language
- ② to know more about China through interacting with local students;
- ③ to broaden the view and knowledge for the students through learning and observing;
- ④ to adapt to collective living and learn to be independent.

◇ **Highlights:**

We have developed a hands-on curriculum that constantly emphasizes to promote your students' understanding and appreciation of Chinese culture and language. Let me take a few moments to tell you about some of the highlights of this program.

☆ **Daily Mandarin classes and seminars**

We have carefully chosen the Second Attached High School of Beijing Normal University, a very well respected school in Beijing. Every morning, students will attend Mandarin classes with experienced teachers who know how to work with students to get the best results. We will also invite professors from the University to visit and speak to your students about many aspects of

Chinese culture, customs, and art.

☆ **Hands-on learning about Chinese Culture**

We have arranged a number of classes and seminars that will broaden the students' awareness of other aspects of Chinese culture. These will include practicing Taiji with a master, learning about the essence of Chinese scroll paintings, and trying their hand at the ancient art of calligraphy.

☆ **Field trips and off-campus learning**

In this aspect, the students will attend a number of evening performances to see Peking Opera, Chinese Kung Fu and acrobatics shows. The students will learn about "Xiang Sheng," or Cross talk, a fast-paced and witty dialogue between two performers, and will even learn some Chinese tongue-twisters from the performers.

☆ **Chinese Language Partner Program**

To further help each student practices the skills they are learning in the classroom, we will arrange for one-on-one or small group chats with some of the local high school students. These Chinese partners are carefully chosen from the top performance local school students of the similar age group, and they will be partnered up with our students in the orientation session, interim break mini-sports game session, and the closing ceremony session. Occasionally, they will also join our students for some of the evening Chinese language partner program sessions. These informal conversations are a great way to improve oral Chinese.

◇ **Activities for parents**

Parents are suggested to travel with your children to visit historical

interests and shopping in the destination.

We wish your children to have a fantastic holiday during this Beijing Cultural trip.

◇ Fees

The fee is about \$ 1698 including return tickets, accommodation, travel & sightseeing, studying materials, insurance and so on.
